Reportable Codes

Category/Code	Description
✕ SERIOUS REPORT IMMEDIATELY:	
911	Wrong patient, wrong site surgical procedure
912	Incorrect procedure or treatment - invasive
913	Unintentionally retained foreign body
915	Unexpected deaths (including delay in treatment, diagnoses or an omission of care, including neonate \geq 28 weeks AND \geq 1000 grams AND no life threatening anomalies)
916	Cardiac and/or respiratory arrest requiring ACLS intervention (including delay in treatment, diagnosis or an omission of care)
917	Loss of limb or organ (including delay in treatment, diagnosis or an omission of care)
918	Impairment of limb, organ or body function (including delay in treatment, diagnosis or an omission of care)
938	Malfunction of equipment during treatment or diagnosis, or a defective product resulting in death or serious injury
✕ Medication Errors (Requires corresponding 900 code)	
108	Medication error occurred that resulted in permanent harm patient harm
109	Medication error occurred that resulted in near-death event
110	Medication error occurred that resulted in patient death
Embolitic & Related Disorders (include readmissions within 30 days)	
401	New acute pulmonary embolism (PE)
402	New documented deep vein thrombosis (DVT)
Peri-op/ Periprocedural related (day of, or 1st or 2nd day after procedure including readmissions)	
604	Acute myocardial infarction (AMI) unrelated to a cardiac procedure
Burns/Falls	
701	Burns (2 nd or 3 rd degree burns occurring during inpatient or outpatient service encounters)
751	Falls resulting in x-ray proven fractures, subdural or epidural hematoma, cerebral contusion, traumatic subarachnoid hemorrhage, and/or internal trauma (e.g., hepatic or splenic injury)

Surgical Related Infection within 30 days of surgical procedure while hospitalized (include readmissions within 30 days)	
808	Post op wound infection requiring I&D, IV antibiotics or hospital admission within 30 days.
Other NYPORTS reportable	
901	Other serious occurrence warranting DOH notification
902	Specific patient transfers from diagnostic and treatment center to hospital
914	Misadministration of radiation or radioactive material
921	Crime resulting in death or serious injury
922	Suicides and attempted suicides related to an inpatient hospitalization, with serious injury
923	Elopement from hospital resulting in death or serious injury
931	Strike by hospital staff
932	External disaster outside the control of the hospital which effects facility operation
933	Termination of any services vital to the continued safe operation of the hospital or to the health and safety of its patients and personnel
934	Poisoning occurring within the hospital (water, air, food)
935	Hospital fire or other internal disaster disrupting patient care or causing harm to patients or staff
937	Malfunction of equipment during treatment or diagnosis or a defecion product which as a potential for adversely affecting patient or hospital personnel or results in a retained foreign body
961	Infant abduction
962	Infant discharged to wrong family
963	Rape of a patient
