Scope # practices/physicians/covered lives:

- 16/54/19,000
- Developing strategies to garner additional ASO lives to reach a minimum of 30,000 lives

Practice qualification:

- NCQA PPC-PCMH

Community integration:

- Building Medical Neighborhoods and utilizing a Patient Navigator expert to help our practices find the resources in their area as well as offer them a list of known resources in Denver Metro

Integration with wellness/disease prevention:

- Pilot practices are accessing community programs provided by the Health Dept., community resources (i.e. Healthier Living) , & non-health care related support services (i.e. faith-based organizations)

Evaluation:

- Independent evaluation using a Matched Comparison Group Methodology to evaluate the effectiveness of PCMH qualities on cost, quality and satisfaction for both provider office and patient

Administrative entity/ongoing management:

- Colorado Clinical Guidelines Collaborative (CCGC)

Attribution:

- Health plans and practices

Quality measurement

- Colorado Clinical Guidelines Collaborative (CCGC)

Payment model:

- 3 Tier Payment System: FFS; PMPM care coordination fee; P4P

Support to practices:

- On-site QI coaching, learning community webinars & learning collaborative.
- Practices submit monthly narrative progress reports & QI measures which span prevention, wellness and chronic disease.
- Practices must have registry functionality for population management & care coordinator.
