



Selected Evaluation Quality Measures and Data Sources for Six Texas Demonstrations

This snapshot, based on our understanding of available documents, illustrates the scope and complexity of the information used to evaluate six Texas demonstrations. The rows in **yellow** are CMS core quality measures. “X” indicates federal reporting measures. “TX” indicates measures collected for state use.

In addition to the evaluation measures indicated below, some programs have extensive pay-for-performance and pay-for-reporting requirements. For example, 27 of the 68 rows in the below table are DSRIP pay-for-performance or pay-for-reporting measures.
